## HILL HAVEN RANCH RULES

Thank you for following the Ranch Rules. They make Hill Haven a fun, safe place to be for our riders, guests, and horses. As soon as you enter Ranch property, you must sign a liability release form provided by the ranch, no exceptions! You will not be permitted on Hill Haven Ranch property without a signed liability release.

## General Rules

- 1. Please be respectful and courteous to people and animals around you, and Hill Haven Ranch property.
- 2. For your health, no smoking, drugs, or alcohol are allowed.
- 3. We love animals but for your safety and theirs, no dogs or other pets may be brought onto the property.
- 4. Drive slowly and enjoy the view. The speed limit is 5 MPH. Please watch for animals and children.
- 5. We enjoy off-roading, but please park in designated parking area only.
- 6. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times. Kids, keep an eye on the adults too.
- 7. We all love exploring, but please stay out of all buildings and remain in the main lesson area unless escorted by a Ranch staff member or volunteer. And watch out, the fences ARE electrified, trust us.
- 8. Watch your step, no open toed or high heeled footwear anywhere on property. The ground may be soft or uneven which may lead to an injury even if not riding or handling a horse.

9. We know you're excited, but no running, screaming, or disruptive behavior, especially around the horses. Horse Safety

- 10. Helmets must be worn at all times while around horses.
- 11. Students must wear long pants, and closed toed shoes. Appropriate footwear includes running shoes, hiking boots, or riding boots (preferred and in-style).
- 12. If you notice damage to any horse's tack, stall, paddock, pasture, or barn, please notify the Ranch management immediately. We will need to make repairs so no one is injured.
- 13. Do not climb on gates, fences, or stalls. Gates must remain closed when not in use.
- 14. When watching lessons remain calm and quiet so the instructor, students, and horses are not disrupted.
- 15. If any rider falls, other riders must halt and dismount immediately, then alert Ranch Management and/or 911 for help if needed. Any accident must be reported to Ranch Management immediately.
- 16. Keep all horses under control at all times. Always use a lead rope unless in round pen or arena area.
- 17. If any horse gets loose, all riders must halt and dismount until the loose horse is caught.
- 18. We will not tolerate abuse or mistreatment of any animal or person. You will be asked to leave if this behavior is observed.

## House Keeping

- 19. Pick up and put away all equipment after use. If you used it, put it back where it belongs!
- 20. Grooming areas must be swept off after each use.
- 21. All manure must be removed from barn isle, grooming areas, and riding areas. If it is anywhere but in a stall or paddock, it must be cleaned up promptly. If your horse leaves manure in the riding arena, please clean it up promptly so it isn't mixed into the sand. Help us keep the ranch clean and tidy for all to enjoy!
